TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, GREETING:

**Know ye,** That Michael Engle of  
Jefferson County, Ohio,

having deposited in the Treasury a certificate of the Register of the Land-office at Steubenville,  
whereby it appears that he has made full payment for the  
North East Quarter of Section number Thirty two, of Town-  
ship number eighteen, in Range number Seven,

of the lands directed to be sold at Steubenville,  
by the act of Congress, entitled "An act providing for the sale of the lands of the United States  
in the territory north-west of the Ohio, and above the mouth of Kentucky river," and of  
the acts amendatory of the same, There is granted, by the United States, unto the said  
Michael Engle, the Quarter lot or section  
of land above described: To have and to hold the said Quarter lot or  
section of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said Michael  
Engle his heirs and assigns forever.

In testimony whereof, I have caused these letters to be made Patent,  
and the seal of the United States to be hereunto affixed.
