and after my funeral expences, and all my
lawful debts are paid, I give and bequeath
all my property, both real and personal,
unto my children to be divided equally
among them, except my Daughter Catharine
~~Catherine~~ Deceased; therefore it is my will
that her share shall fall unto John
~~John~~ the heir of my said Daughter,
Catharine, But my will is that my Daughter
Catharine's share shall be reserved until
her son John shall arrive at the age of
twenty one years.

And further it is my will that my son Isaac
and my son-in-law Barney Goke shall be

executors of my estate after my decease

in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight
